With regards to the long-range tactical role of the Allied heavy bombers, only the period from May to October is examined, while they remained based in North Africa, with the narrative continuing in a future volume. This volume also delves into the story of "the soldiers' air force." Frequently overshadowed by more immediate newsworthy events elsewhere, the soldiers' struggle was often of an equally Homeric nature. "No future publication on the Mediterranean air war will be credible without use of this series." —*Air Power History*
