Government facilities are used to defend the national interest; conduct foreign policy; house historic, cultural and educational artifacts; pursue research; and provide services to the American public. This paper introduces a new method, different from the discounted cash flow (DCF) method, for the first time, to estimate NPV and IRR. This method makes use of the capital amortization schedule (CAS). Accordingly, the present value (PV) of the final closing balance (CB) in a CAS, at a specific discount rate, is the NPV at that rate and the interest rate that makes the final CB zero is the IRR. The estimated NPV and IRR by CAS and DCF methods are perfectly matching in all cases of small or large-scale investments and under the financial and economic analysis of investments. The advantages of the transparent CAS/MCAS methods include: a. identification of reinvestment, if any, of intermediate income; b. elimination of reinvestment, if there is any; c. resolving the problems of multiple IRR and leading to a unique and real IRR; and d. estimation of IRR on total capital. A modified CAS (MCAS) method is introduced that eliminates the reinvestment income to get a unique IRR that resolves the problem of multiple IRR. When there is multiple IRR, the application of NPV rule without eliminating the reinvestment will be misleading. This analysis also helps to identify the appropriate criterion between IRR and NPV, as NPV indicates the unutilized NCF whereas IRR indicates the return on invested capital (ROIC) by fully utilizing the NCF. The investors are comfortable to compare the IRR with the cost of capital in percentage term. As the modified IRR (MIRR) assumes reinvestment, MIRR might become redundant if there is no reinvestment (with NCF and some NNCF) and this is an incidental inference.
