female athletes, and about young adult  
dystopian fiction. Gender itself is further  
explored in articles about Monster High,  
Joyce Carol Oates's Beasts, and The  
Hunger Games and Divergent. Essays  
about fantasy literature include an  
exploration of environmentalism in Rick  
Riordan's The Heroes of Olympus, a  
discussion of Severus Snape as a Judas  
figure, an explication of Chapter 5 of The  
Hobbit, and an analysis of ghosts and

nationalism in Eva Ibbotson's *The Haunting of Granite Falls*. An essay about *Horrible Histories* explores television, genre, and the way history is coded.
