Have you decided that your skin tag is bothering you; As long as the tag is not infected or near a delicate area, you can remove it yourself at home. Pores and skin tags are painless, non-cancerous

growths on your skin; they're linked to your skin by a little, slim stalk called a peduncle. Epidermis/skin tags are regular in men and women, especially after age group 50; they can show up anywhere on the body, though they're common within places where your skin layer folds like the: -Armpits. -Groin. -Thighs. -Eyelids. -Neck. -Area under your breasts. As pores and skin tags are usually safe, removal is generally for visual or aesthetic reasons. Large epidermis/skin tags, especially in areas where they could rub against something, such as clothing, jewelry or pores, and skin, may be removed credited to irritation.
