Three years later, Summit Entertainment acquired the rights to the film. After Twilight grossed \$35.7 million on its opening day, Summit Entertainment announced they would begin production on New Moon; they had acquired the

rights to the remaining novels earlier that same month. A two-part adaptation of Breaking Dawn began shooting in November 2010 with November 18, 2011, and November 16, 2012, release dates. Twilight was in development for approximately three years at Paramount Pictures's MTV Films, during which time a screen adaptation differing significantly from the novel was written.
