Negotiating a ConversationThe approach this course uses recognizes that it takes new Spanish speakers years to become fluent. However, if a nurse learns the medical vocabulary and strategies to properly negotiate a conversation, (s)he can learn to work through

virtually any situation in a relatively short period of time. For example, if a patient says something a nurse doesn't understand, the nurse can ask them to repeat it or say it slower. If a nurse doesn't know how to say something, (s)he can point to it and ask ¿Cómo se dice? (How do you say that.) However, if a nurse only uses technology, this provides a poor patient experience and demonstrates poor bedside manner. Also, if only technology is used, body language and gestures are missed and the meaning can be misinterpreted.
